### Pearl Harbor

- 10- Luckily, these 2 types of vessels were not at Pearl Harbor
- 20- He was the mastermind of the attack for Japan
- 30- Actual island U.S. thought Japan would attack
- 40- month/ date/ year/ time/ and day of the attack

### Maps Asia/ Pearl Harbor

- 10- 2 major islands Japan was kept from taking
- 20- 4 major island chains U.S. begins to take back
- 30- 3 air bases Japan attacked at Pearl Harbor
- 40- Name 5 battleships attacked on Ford Island (Battleship Row)

### Doolittle's Raid

- 10- City that he attacked in 1942
- 20- Type of planes used in attack (not from the book!)
- 30- Name of carrier they launched from
- 40- Why did the planes have to take off 100 miles outside their take off spot?

### Bataan Death March

- 10- # of prisoners taken by Japan
- 20- # of mile the march totaled
- 30- # of deaths from the U.S. and Filipinos
- 40- 3 examples of torture put upon our troops

### Atomic Bomb

- 10- Name given to secret project/ and 2 cities bombs were dropped
- 20- 2 nicknames of atomic bombs (think of Mr. K) and types of atomic bombs
- 30- Town and state where we tested the weapon in U.S.
- 40- He was the commander of the project throughout the war

### Iwo Jima

- 10- This was the purpose of taking Iwo Jima from Japan
- 20- Famous mountain Marines finally take!
- 30- This was the actual size of Iwo Jima in square miles
- 40- This was the number of Japanese dug in on Iwo Jima

### Okinawa

- 10- This was the most effective weapon used by the U.S. in taking the island
- 20- Strategic importance of taking Okinawa
- 30- The campaign to overtake Okinawa was known as operation.....
- 40- This was the number of Japanese killed on Okinawa

### Corregidor

- 10- Nickname given to island
- 20- Island chain was it part of
- 30- Under orders from Roosevelt, he escaped capture by the Japanese by reaching Australia
- 40- This Lt. General was left in charge of Corregidor

### Study Guide Pacific (use your book!)

- 10- Name given to U.S. strategy to overtake islands
- 20- This was the actual size of Japanese empire global wide (hint fraction)
- 30- This Indian tribe was known as the code talkers

40- This is the amount of Americans experts believed would be killed in an invasion of Japan

### **Pacific War Trivia**

- 10- Name of admiral who headed U.S. naval forces
- 20- Island MacArthur was forced to evacuate and quote he made upon leaving
- 30- This battle was the turning point of the Pacific war
- 40- U.S. battleship where surrender of Japan took place

### **Midway Battle**

- 10- Japanese admiral who planned Midway battle
- 20- Number of carriers lost by U.S. and Japan
- 30- 3 U.S. carriers that took part in the battle
- 40- U.S. island Japan wanted to invade after Midway

### **Coral Sea Battle**

- 10- Island Japan tried to overtake which led to battle
- 20- U.S. carrier Japan thought they sunk at battle of Coral Sea
- 30- Unique fact regarding ships for both sides during battle
- 40- The significance of Coral Sea for the U.S. was this

### **Mr. K's Ultimate Trivia 1**

- 10- This island battle began the U.S. island hopping takeover
- 20- pilot who flew the Enola Gay over Hiroshima
- 30- 5 brothers who were killed on U.S. carrier in Pacific (made history)
- 40- 1st marine and 7th marine divisions suffered fatalities trying to take this island

### **Fighting to the Death/ Name that island**

- 10- 350,000 Japanese died trying to keep the U.S. from taking this island
- 20- Of 30,000 Japanese on this island, only 3,000 survived
- 30- Of 4700 Japanese on this island only 17 survived
- 40- Of 21,000 Japanese on this island only 200 survived

### **Videos/ Videos/ Videos**

- 10- Japanese resorted to this "tactic" when all was lost
- 20- These 2 fighting units were mainly used for "island hopping"
- 30- "Tora Tora Tora" translated!
- 40- Clint Eastwood directed this major battle from the Japanese perspective!!

### **Name that operation**

- 10- The Allied operation aimed at capturing Rangoon May 3, 1945 (Think vampire)
- 20- Japanese attempt to bomb the U.S. Northwest Forest with hydrogen balloons
- 30- U.S. planned invasion of Okinawa on Easter Sunday April 1, 1945
- 40- U.S. effort to recapture the Gilbert Islands from Japan in 1943

### **Mr. K.'s Ultimate Trivia 2**

- 10- This was the nickname given to Japan's propaganda Queen, GIs heard her constantly on the radio
- 20- This was Japan's ultimate battleship, they thought it was unsinkable! (They were wrong!)
- 30- On what ship were those 5 famous brothers killed from Waterloo, Iowa
- 40- This was the name of FDR's Personal Aircraft (India loves them)
